

Standard 3. Study Program Objectives

The Study Program has clearly defined objectives.

The main objective of the Study Program is the training of competent professionals in the field of research and medical ethics that will be able to respond in an adequate way to complex issues of preservation and improvement of ethical standards in basic and clinical research and possess the knowledge and skills required for the implementation of international ethical standards in the field of research in human population and experimental animals.

Also, the objective is to make candidates qualified to perform the following tasks: evaluation of ethical aspects of the research; identification of ethical problems and finding ways to overcome them; having candidates meet the requirements for membership in Ethics Committees; research and risk and threat management regarding the maintenance of ethical norms; monitoring and supporting the promotion of ethical aspects in clinical studies and research practice at the institutional and national levels; social participation in the preservation and improvement of ethical standards; development of policies for the improvement of ethical standards and practices through participatory processes within existing socio-economic relations; support for ensuring equality of vulnerable groups; development and training of human resources in the field of medical and research ethics; social participation in preserving and promoting ethical principles etc. The candidates will also acquire the knowledge and skills necessary for the formulation of legal norms concerning ethics in the field of medical and scientific research legislation.
