

Standard 2. The Purpose of the Study Program

The Study Program has a clearly defined purpose and its role in the education system, accessible to the public.

Upon completion of the Study Program, students will be able to: research and analyze ethical issues; participate in the implementation of legal norms in the field of medical and research ethics regulations; develop, lead and evaluate ethical aspects in research, application of new technologies and new therapeutic strategies; and create wide partnerships in the implementation of ethical standards and principles.

The purpose and the role of the Study Program also relates to the acquisition of knowledge and skills in the analysis of international ethical documents (declarations), as well as in adapting international goals in the field of medical and research ethics to the specific characteristics of the our country environment, with the selection of appropriate indicators to monitor the improvement of the ethical standards' application in the fields of biomedical and public health research and practice.
